## **Abstract**

The concept of inclusive of Health & Rehabilitation is new in Bangladesh perspectives, as here the Health and Rehabilitation services are separately delivered by the govt. Authority at the government health complexes by the initiatives of NGO. The study mainly find out the acceptance, understanding, and recommendations for further development of the Health and Rehabilitation program running govt. Health complexes in 3 different districts of Bangladesh. Methodology: The participants of the study were Patients & care giver, Hospital staffs and Community clinic and NGO staff who are currently involved with the program. Data was collected by structure questionnaire and data analysis done by SPSS. 100 responded from different categories were participated in the study from Manikgonj, Chittagong and Satkhira districts and opinion between all participants also comparatively analyzed. Result: The study found that the program is running well by following the better referral mechanism with the community clinic hospitals and therapy center where 50% of the caregivers of parents and 100% government health service providers responded that they are maintaining the referral mechanism and that are very much helpful for the patients to avail the services. There are very little limitations they stated as lack of therapy materials, human resources and very small spaces with not all the services are available for all type of disability, which also recommended by the participants to overcome soon. The study also found that, as the stakeholder of the inclusive health and rehabilitation program 77.2% of hospital staff and 100% of CHCP have the good experience with the program in terms of referring and providing the services towards the person with disabilities.
